Tournament Rules Synopsis

- 20 ends of 2 minutes
- 10 Ring or Triangle
- X ring is 11 all divisions
- Outer 10 for all divisions
- Qualification Round -Alternating Shooting
- Elimination Round-AB Shoots first (top)
- Recurve Set Scoring for Elimination Round
- Qualification has medical or equipment failure make up arrows
- Eliminations DO NOT have medical or equipment failure make up arrows
- Eliminations-missing first end of official practice is disqualification

Tournament Rules Cont

- Missing first end of a non bye match is a disqualification
- Mark Arrow Holes
- One arrow shoot offs shoot on the target style they competed on.
 Triangles must shoot top spot.
- Single eliminations-exception is Semi final loss shoots in Bronze Medal Match
- Dress Code enforced. See tournament rules link on second page.
- Shoes must cover ENTIRE foot, including the heel
- Archers are 100% responsible for their scorecard and digital accuracy.

Believe it or not, the building we shoot in does have an official address. You ready?

N Biscuit Flat Drive, 4040 W Black Canyon Blvd Phoenix, AZ 85086.

You can not plug that into your gps, sorry.

So here are some general directions.

We start from the Main entrance for Ben Avery on Carefree Hwy. (IT IS NOT THE ONE WITH THE STOP LIGHT)

If you are at the one with the stop light you are in the wrong place!!!!

Main entrance has no stoplight (yet). It is about 1/4 mile west of the Carefree Hwy and I-17 intersection. There is a big sign and American and Arizona Flags waiving. Turn North (toward the mountain). Follow the road through the white gate and the road with gradually turn west. You can see the building on your right as the road turns west. Make the first right you get to when you are heading west. We should have a sign there unless it gets stolen again. It looks like you are turning into a parking lot for a pistol range.

Make the next right, this is Biscuit Flat Drive. It is a dirt road. The building is on your right, beige metal building. Park and come on in. Do not use the Handicapped Parking spots unless you have a handicapped sticker or tag. Be on time or early.

Questions:

Archer Seating: Archers are supplied seating away from spectators. Archers can sit will spectators if they choose and bring their own chair.

Spectator Seating: Spectators can not sit in archer's area. They will have an area dedicated to spectators. You will need to bring your own seating.

How long will we be here? Until it is done. I know it sounds flippant and I am sorry. It is not. The 20end qualifying round should take 2.5-3 hours. Eliminations should take 2-2.5 hours if you continue to win.

Is there public Wifi in building? BASF now supplies public WiFi, it is adequate but do not plan on streaming video or games. It is enough to surf the web and look at emails.

What about DSA Wifi? Yes, we pay for our own Wifi. It is restricted to tournament and membership of DSA needs.

Is there a snack bar? A small one serving soft drinks, water and basic candy. Nothing major. Water is free for everyone.

Can you sign up late, a friend might want to shoot? NO.

What are the tournament rules? There will be a quick Q&A prior to the first end of official practice. See earlier in the program for a link to the rules.

Will there be unofficial practice? NO.

Where do I check in? When you come in, go to the DOS stand on the south wall of the bldg.
